Please join us for our intensive summer camp focused on the Orton-Gillingham (OG) approach toward reading/language support! The camp will run June 10-27, Monday-Thursday from 9:30-12:30.

Our camp will focus on reading/language support using the OG approach. OG offers a multi-sensory approach to teaching reading strategies to students. It is language-based, structured, sequential, cumulative, and individualized.

The plan is to have two small groups, capped at 5 students in each group and rotate between two Learning Specialists, who have both been trained in OG. The schedule will be as follows:

45 minutes intensive OG rule/lesson

45 minutes written expression

45 minutes art

45 minutes sustained oral reading/reading comprehension/snack

Registration Fee: \$150 (waived for current EtB students). This will include baseline testing prior to starting camp. \*\* If registration is complete by April 15<sup>th</sup>, registration fee will be waived.



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Deposit of \$510 is required to hold spot. Deposit refundable (minus \$100 processing fee) through May 10. Full payment due no later than May 15.

Students will be grouped with other students who are learning the same OG rules and lessons. There may be occasional review for some students; however, students will be grouped by skills/rule level, and most lessons will cover novel concepts. When, on occasion, there is review, this will serve as an excellent opportunity to practice and reinforce previously learned skills. All students will participate in activities at appropriate developmental and skill levels.

If after baseline testing, we feel that the skills/rules being taught in the intensive OG camp would not be in-line with what your child requires, then we will suggest individualized tutoring. The baseline assessments will provide us with the best information to make the camp successful and fun for your child.

While there will be much learning going on, we plan to have lots of fun doing so! We would love for you to join us!
